PRIORITY SEATING

Priority seating for coaches, teams and fans

- Up front, on the floor
- For your team only (no squatting)
- Enter immediately after the last team's fans have cleared the area
- Exit immediately following your team's performance

WARM-UP AREAS

*Competition Warm-Up (Battelle Hall)

Warm-ups begin one hour prior to performance time. Check the Order of Performance schedule for your check-in and warm-up times.

*Open Warm-Up (Battelle Hall)

CHAMPION EVENT CHECKLIST

Checklist of things to remember to do for this event

- ✓ **Final payment deadline** is March 10 for ALL forms and amount owed. Forms and payment are necessary in order for your teams to compete!
- ✓ **New Contact Person?** If your Official Contact Person has changed since registration, complete the enclosed Contact Change Form and return it by March 10, 2007. Note: It is important to have a Registered Contact Person as they sign for everything received, such as the Code of Conduct, Gifts, Shoe Tags, Wristbands, etc., and they pick up your score sheets from the Champion Booth.
- ✓ **Mandatory Coach's Meeting and Reception Friday, 9:00 pm, Battelle Hall** – in the level one warm-up area. Note: more information will be given throughout the competition as it becomes available.
- ✓ **Code of Conduct** agreement – Unsportsmanlike conduct will NOT be tolerated during the event. Any team (coach, competitor, parent, or supporter) violating this agreement will be assessed a 25-point deduction from your team's final score.
- ✓ **NO videotaping or photography allowed** (Champion Cheer & Dance has a contractual agreement with vendors who provide these services). Security will be collecting ALL CAMERAS inside the arena during competition. This includes video and still cameras of any type, including film, digital, and phones. Violation of this rule will result in a 25-point deduction from your team's final score.
- ✓ **Spectator entrance** should be used by parents and fans.
- ✓ **Team Entrance and Warm-up areas** are off limits to parents and fans. Only coaches, competitors, and Champion staff will be allowed in these areas.
- ✓ **Individual & Partner Stunt Awards** will be given out at the Extreme Rockin' Beach Party, Battelle Hall, on Saturday from 7- 9pm or when the competition is finished.
- ✓ **Score sheets & Critique Tapes** will be available at the Champion Information Booth, in the vendor area on level one, approximately one hour following the end of each division.

- ✓ **National Champions** (Individuals, Stunts, Teams, Coaches) who win a National Championship title may pick up a National Championship T-Shirt at the registration booth on level one after each Award Ceremony. The team members should not come as individuals. ONLY the contact person can pick up awards. Note: the contact person should bring the number and sizes for all winning participants.
- ✓ **2008 National Championship bids** will be awarded during the Final Award Ceremony. These awards will include the following cash awards:
 - \$1,000 – Program Champion
 - \$750 – Champion Cup
 - \$500 – “Spirit of a Champion”
- ✓ **Glitter and gel** should only be applied in bathrooms and if needed in the stands behind the warm-up area.
- ✓ **Rules and guidelines** should be reviewed before competing. Make sure to read all the rules (NACCC/USASF & NFHS) and Champion division guidelines to make sure your team is in the appropriate division and is following the proper level guidelines.
- ✓ **Venue Map** – please familiarize yourself with the event layout and the traffic flow patterns.
